#### VISITATIONS TO BEGIN

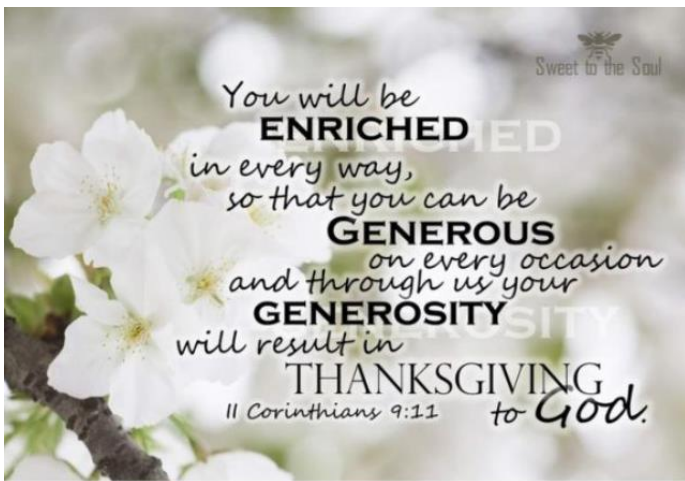
